

Continuums of Care (“CoCs”) - to request RRH and HP Funds

“Households that present **at any agency in the CoC**, regardless of whether it is an agency dedicated to the population to which the household belongs, **can access an appropriate assessment process that provides the CoC with enough information to make prioritization decisions about that household.**”
